This Department is no longer issuing letters of approval for appliance of this type. It is the responsibility of the manufacturer or supplier under the Lifts and Cranes Act 1967 to ensure that the equipment is safe and that it complies with the Act and Regulations.

Please ensure that the equipment built to the design as submitted is marked in accordance with sub-Regulation 27(2) and Schedule 3 of the Cranes Regulations 1989.

The Department of Labour Reference Number 89/20603/00 must be included in the marking.

Your submission may be subject to Departmental audit at a later date. During the audit phase you may be required to submit further information on the equipment.


Should it be found that the equipment does not comply with the Lifts and Cranes Act 1967 and Cranes Regulations 1989, the Reference Number shall be withdrawn and all the equipment built to the design as submitted will be prohibited from use. Prosecution may then be implemented.

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Prior to using the equipment, it is required in accordance with Section 13 of the Lifts and Cranes Act 1967 and sub-Regulation 10(2) of the Cranes Regulations 1989 that a completed Schedule 2 be submitted to the appropriate Departmental Regional Office or the Building and Construction Industry Division (see Attachment A for the nearest Regional Office or the Building and Construction Industry Division).
