Thanks to 24/7 support A.L.P.A. Equipment has been able to build up a good business relationship with Ledwidge Lumber over the years. When the factory needed an additional material handling machine, the company once again got together with their Fuchs dealer and bougt the new MHL350 HD in 2020.

Today all Fuchs purpose-built log handlers play a critical role in log production. They handle the timber and feed the mill with enough material to process the roughly 300,000 board feet of lumber per shift. After the logs are debarked, they are sent through the HewSaw line to cut the boards and then sent to the planer circuit for final sizing.
