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Determine which two buttons need to be changed. In this example Button 2 and 3 will be switched (Strobe Lights and Compartment Lights).

Note: Button 1 is the only button that cannot be changed. PTO will always be the first button.



STEP 2 (Continued)

Click on Settings to continue.


STEP 2

Press the middle button on the display until Settings are displayed. If Settings is not available, this version of the Switch Panel does not support programming by the user.



STEP 3

Use the up/down arrows to select Button Labels. Once it is highlighted, push the select button.



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Use the up/down arrows to highlight the button that needs to be switched. For this example, highlight Button 2, then use the up/down arrows to change Strobe Lights to Compartment Lights. Press the Select button to save the changes.

STEP 5

Use up/down buttons to highlight Button 3. Press the Select button and use the up/down buttons until Strobe Lights are selected as the option. Press the Select button to save the changes.

STEP 6

Press the Home button to return to the Settings screen. Below is the before and after of the button changes.






FIGURE 5 - Before


FIGURE 6 - After

Use the up/down buttons to highlight output settings. Once it is highlight press the select button.



STEP 8

In this example, the original output for Strobe Lights is K6 and Compartment Lights is K7. To change this, use the up/down buttons to highlight the output that needs to be changed. Press the Select button and use the up/down buttons until the box on the right matches the new output. The pictures below are the before and after.






FIGURE 8 - Before
