INTRODUCTION

Not all Canview 4 switch panels have the ability to be programmed. Do not install any software without prior approval from Terex Utilities.

Note: Depending on the age of the unit, there are three ways the software will be installed.

Note: The update process can take from a few seconds to over 10 minutes to complete.

STEP 1

Copy the software onto a blank USB flash drive. An example of the file is shown below.

STEP 2

Follow the wires from the back of the switch panel and locate the USB port. It should have a red dust cap covering it.



STEP 3

Determine the software version currently installed using Tech-tip 117 as a reference.

Note: When updating from an older version of software to 2.6.3.3 or higher, additional steps are required.

Software versions less than 2.3.0

Software versions between 2.3.0 and 2.6.3.2

Upgrading from software version 2.6.3.2 and lower to 2.6.3.3 and above

Software versions less than 2.3.0 STEP 1

Remove the cap and insert the flash drive into the port. Disconnect power by removing the connector on the back of the switch panel.



Push down buttons 2 and 4 at the same time. Continue holding these buttons while reconnecting the connector from Step 1.

STEP 3

After the black screen is displayed, a prompt will appear to update the application. Push YES to continue.



Software versions 2.3.0 and above STEP 1

Remove the cap and insert the flash drive into the port. Press the "Home/Select" button until the "Settings" option appears on the right-hand side of the screen. Press "Settings" to continue.



STEP 3

Press and hold the button labeled "Hold to Upload Prgm" until the screen goes black.

STEP 2

Scroll through "Settings" until "Configurate Page" is available. Once highlighted, press the "Select" button.



STEP 4

After the black screen is displayed, a prompt will appear to update the application. Push YES to continue.

Upgrading from a lower software version to 2.6.3.3 or higher STEP 1

STEP 4

If the configuration is exported successfully, the Print Config" button will turn green. Press and hold the "Hold to Upload Prgm" button to load the new program.

STEP 5

When the screen comes back on after reprograming, navigate back to "Configuration" page and press the "Import Config" button. The button will darken, then press the "Import Config" button again to import the configuration.
