

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## TECH TIP#136

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#### INTRODUCTION

Use **Tech Tip 117** to determine the software version used on the panel.

If the version is prior to 2.5.4.1, only follow steps 1-5.

For software version 2.5.4.1 and newer, jump to Step 6.

#### STEP 1 - Version 2.5.4.0 and older

Press the "Home/Select" button until "Settings" appears on the right-hand side of the screen. Press the "Settings" button.



#### STEP 2

Scroll through "Settings" until "Control Settings" is available. Once highlighted, press the "Select" button.



### STEP 3

Scroll through "Control Settings" until "Work Lights" is available. Once highlighted, press the "Select" button.



#### STEP 4

Options will appear in the box on the right. Scroll through until "Toggle" is displayed. Press the "Select" button.



#### STEP 5

Press the "home/select" button until the "Function" screen is shown again. Test the work light functionality to verify it is working without engaging the park brake ON.



### STEP 6 - Version 2.5.4.1 and newer

Press the "Home/Select" button until "Settings" appears on the right-hand side of the screen. Press the "Settings" button.




#### STEP 7

Scroll through "Settings" until "Button Labels" is available. Once highlighted, press the "Select" button.



### STEP 8

Scroll through "Button Labels" until "Work Lights" is available. Once highlighted, press the "Behavior" button.



#### STEP 9

Scroll through "Button Labels" until "Work Lights" is available. Once highlighted, press the "Behavior" button.



### **STEP 10**

Press "Back" and then the "Home/Select". Test the work light functionality to verify it is working without engaging the park brake ON.
