

INTRODUCTION

Maintain proper oil levels in the gearboxes to dissipate heat. Too much or too little oil in the gearbox may lead to premature failure.

Due to how the winch gearbox is mounted on the boom tip shown in **Figure 1**, using the oil level hole will not provide an accurate measurement of the oil in the gearbox.

According to the maintenance manual, the oil should be drained and refilled every 6 months. Consult the lube chart mounted on the unit and the unit specific maintenance manual for the proper fluid to be added and the maintenance interval. **Figure 2**





STEP 1

Locate unit in a safe location and operate the boom allow access to the PG (Pole Guide) winch from the ground.

STEP 2

Position a drain pan under the winch gearbox and remove the drain plug. **Figure 3**



STEP 3

Replace the drain plug once all the oil is removed. **Figure 4**

STEP 4

Remove the breather vent and add 2.5 quarts of 85w/140 gear oil to the gearbox. **Figure 3**
